Greetings, Young Shooting Sports Enthusiasts! Are you are interested in learning rifle shooting skills?

We will be starting our **WINNEQUAH JUNIOR SMALL BORE** (.22) **RIFLE** and **AIR RIFLE PROGRAMS** on **Mon**, **Oct 2nd** from **5:30 to 8:00pm.** The first regular night will be primarily for equipment checking, filing out forms and starting the shooting for the season. It will continue every Monday through March. You may join at any time during the season and participate as often as your schedule permits.

The program is at the Winnequah Gun Club Indoor Range and Training Facility! It is located at the northern intersection of J and V near Harmony Grove, North of Lodi. We welcome shooters from all areas, including all counties in the south central area of Wisconsin.

This <u>Program of rifle marksmanship skill development</u> is for <u>boys and girls</u> of all ages with no previous experience necessary and consists of:

- 22 evenings of instruction and practice in Olympic style shooting using .22 cal Target Rifles or Air Rifles Supervised by NRA
 certified Instructors and other experienced coaches.
- Participation for those interested in the NRA Winchester Qualification Program with awards and medals at each level of achievement. Junior members can take 2 to 3 seasons to complete the 140 qualifying targets to reach the `EXPERT' badge and the 40 additional targets to reach the `DISTINGUISHED EXPERT' badge. It is possible to accomplish the total program in a little more than a year.
- Opportunities for competition in 5 or more sectional, State and club Matches.
- Opportunities to participate in the High Power Rifle competition and other shooting sports opportunities.

Winnequah Gun Club Provides Air Rifles and .22 cal target rifles, spotting scopes, shooting coats, mats, gloves, etc. and assistance with ammo. The Club provides liability insurance and NRA, USA shooting, and CMP affiliation. <u>A Parent or guardian must be present to register shooters under the age of 18 the first night, and would be welcomed to help with weekly assistance in running the club programs (scoring targets, coaching, etc).</u> Youth can compete until they reach the age of 21 in the junior program.

(At registration the following is needed, youth's Address, DOB, contact phone, medical information and NRA # if registered. All provided information is maintained in a confidential manner.)

Match Fees (optional)

\$6 per 100 rounds, \$20 per 325 rounds includes target velocity .22LR, use of a club target rifle, coat, glove, and other equipment. Ammunition costs for the year are dependent on the number of nights participating in shooting sports.

The member will be responsible for Individual match fees (usually about\$10-15 per match). The club will pay the Team fees and provides ammunition for all matches attended.

\$6 per 500 rounds includes pellets, a club rifle, coat, glove, and other equipment. Pellet costs for the year are dependent on the number of nights participating.

The member will be responsible for Individual match fees (usually about\$10-15 per match). The club will pay the Team fees and provides ammunition for all matches attended.

NRA JR Membership (optional) \$15 Includes NRA Insights magazine for Juniors and membership is needed for some matches.

Ammunition costs are based on the actual replacement costs at time of club purchase for the junior program.
