Sun. May 5,2024 1000 yd 4-Man Team, Any Rifle, Any Sight (after Palma® Individual)

LOCATION: Winnequah Gun Club is approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 West to Exit 115; turn right onto County Road CS (0.2 mile); turn left at County Road J (1.1 mile); turn right at County Road J at the T in the road (3.3 miles). Look for Winnequah Gun Club sign and Indoor Range on your left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. The club address is: W10219 Larson Dr., Lodi WI 53555. More information is on the club web site. Camping is permitted; the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Friday, May 3.

<u>RULES</u>: Current NRA High Power Rifle Long Range and F Class Long Range Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

<u>SAFETY</u>: If a competitor fails to get on target in **FIVE SHOTS** he/she will be directed to stop firing. Bolts cannot be closed until the rifle is should ered and pointed towards the target.

ELIGIBILITY: Competitors must be an NRA member to set a NRA National Record. Teams will consist of four members. An alternate and non-firing captain and coach may also be named, or the captain and coach may be firing members of the team. A team captain **MUST** be named (Rule 12.2). Team representation Club-Rule 2.11; Law Enforcement Agency-Rule 2.14; Service-Rule 2.13; State Association-Rule 2.12; or Junior-Rule 2.18.

ENTRIES: Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA Long Range Prone or F Class Prone classification. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.7 Assigned Classification or 19.2 Temporary Classification may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament. Individual match entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (128) until May 2. Entries received after May 2 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee.

<u>Team entries</u> must be made at the Stat Office by the Team Captain before 12:45 pm May 5, 2024, limited to 32 teams. <u>DO NOT MAIL IN TEAM FEES – ENTRY FORM ONLY. TEAM FEES MUST BE PAID BY TEAM CAPTAIN AT THE</u> <u>STAT OFFICE.</u>

TARGETS:

Long Range targets will be used at 800,900,1000 yd. F Class targets will be used at 800,900,1000 yd – LR-FC.

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding cards for individual matches will be issued from the Stat Office. Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing each day. **If your NRA Long Range and F Class prone classification has changed, please show your new card before squadding is issued.** A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose their right to compete in the event.

<u>COURSE OF FIRE:</u> The Silver Mountain Electronic Target System will be used for scoring. Competitors will be required to score/verify. Please bring a spotting scope or binoculars for verifying all shots fired on the target. Failure to do score/verifying duties may result in a DQ.

Saturday, May 4: Match 1: Palma® Individual Course, 15 shots each at 800,900,1000 yds; 22 minutes each stage (unlimited sighters at 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900, 1000 yds)

Match 2(pm): Palma® Individual Course, 20 shots each at 1000 yds; 30 minutes (unlimited sighters) (Palma® Rifle Iron Sights)

Sunday, May 5: Match 3: Palma® Individual Course, 15 shots each at 800,900,1000 yds; 22 minutes each stage (unlimited sighters 800 yds; 2 sighters at 900,1000 yds)

Match 4: Regional Championship Aggregate of Matches 1,2 and 3 Match 5: 4-Man Team Match, 2 sighters and 20 shots each for record at 1000 yds, 120 min

CATEGORIES AND CLASSES: Separate class and aggregate awards will be given for civilian service rifle and service rifle if there are more than 5 competitors in each category. There will be no separate categories in the Match Rifle Division. 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards will be given only if there are 5,10,15 or more competitors in a given match and class. If there are fewer than 5 High Masters entered, they must fire for Open awards only. High Master Class may not be combined with the Master Class. If there are fewer than 5 entries in a class for awards, they will be combined with the same class in another category. If there are still fewer than 5 entries after combining all categories, there will be NO AWARDS in that class, and all competitors in the lower class will be moved back to their respective category in the next higher class, until there are a minimum of 5 competitors in the combined class.

SPECIAL AWARDS CATEGORIES: An award will be given to the High Grand Senior, High Woman, High Senior (Rule 2.2.1), High Junior (2 or more) (Rule 2.3)(Match 4). A special award will be given if there are three or more teams using a Service Rifle or Palma® Rifle (all team members must use same type of rifle to be eligible)(Match 5).

• F Class competitors will compete only among themselves and <u>ARE NOT</u> eligible for Overall or Class awards in the matches. Awards in F Class will be made based upon the number of F Class competitors (5 or more) in that match.
