**Silver Mountain Electronic Target System will be used. The club has a limited number of tablets – please bring your own.**

**(NO PULLING TARGETS)**

**DATE:** Saturday May 25, 2024, Across the Course Individual, 200,300,600 yds (firing time 8:30 am)  
Sunday, May 26, 2024, Three 1000 yd Matches (firing time 8:30 am)  
Monday, May 27, 2024, Two 1000 yd Pair Fire Matches (May 26 and 27 would be long range only)

**LOCATION:** Winnequah Gun Club is approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 West to Exit 115; turn right onto County Road CS (0.2 mile); turn left at County Road J (1.1 mile); turn right at County Road J at the T in the road (3.3 miles). Look for Winnequah Gun Club sign and Indoor Range on your left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. The club address is: W10219 Larson Dr., Lodi WI 53555. More information is on the club web site. Camping is permitted; the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Friday, May 24.

**RULES:** Current NRA High Power Rifle Across the Course, Long Range and F Class Long Range Prone Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

**SAFETY:** If a competitor fails to get on target in **FIVE SHOTS** he/she will be directed to stop firing. Bolts cannot be closed until the rifle is shouldered and pointed towards the target.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all competitors.

**EQUIPMENT:**

- Palma® Rifle-Rule 3.3.3; metallic sights only-Rule 3.7(a)
- Service Rifle-Rule 3.1,3.1.1,3.1.2,3.1.3 (includes .223 rem)
- F Class-Rule 3.4.1 in NRA High Power Rifle Rules, Section 22

**ENTRIES:** Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assigned Classification, or 19.2-Temporary Classification may be used. Confirmations will be sent by email/US mail. Mail individual entry form with correct fees to:

Entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (128) until May 23). Entries received after May 23 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee.

**TARGETS:**

Across the Course targets will be used at 200,300,600 yd

Long Range targets will be used at 800,900,1000 yd

F Class targets will be used at 800,900,1000 yd-LR-FC

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded at the Stat Office. Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing each day. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose their right to compete in that event.

**COURSE OF FIRE: COACHING ALLOWED FOR SIGHTING SHOTS ONLY.** The Silver Mountain Electronic Target System will be used for scoring. Competitors will be required to score/verify. Please bring a spotting scope or binoculars for verifying all shots fired on the target. Failure to do score/verifying duties may result in a DQ.

- Match 1: Across the Course Individual match (80 shot)
- Match 2: Three 1000 yd matches
- Match 3: Two 1000 yd Pair Fire matches (May 26 and 27 would be long range only)
- Match 4: Aggregate Matches 1,2,3

**AWARDS:** An appropriate award will be given to the Open Winner. If entries warrant, there will be class awards. Special awards will be given to the High Senior, High Woman and High Junior, regardless of entries in Match 4. An appropriate award will be given for the High Service Rifle, Grand Senior, F Class if there are 5 or more competitors. F Class shooters will not be eligible for any other awards.
