DATE: Friday September 13, 2024-Three 1000 vd Matches (entries close 8:00 am)(starts at 8:30 am) Saturday, September 14, 2024-Three 1000 yd PAIR FIRE Matches (entries close 8:00)(starts at 8:30) Sunday, September 15, 2024-Two 1000 yd Matches (entries close 8:00 am)(starts at 8:30 am)

LOCATION: Winnequah Gun Club is approximately three miles north of Lodi, WI. Take I-90/94 West to Exit 115; turn right onto County Road CS (0.2 miles); turn left at County Road J (1 mile); turn right at County Road J at the T in the road (3.3 miles). Look for Winnequah Gun Club sign and Indoor Range on your left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. The club address is: W10219 Larso Dr., Lodi WI 53555. More information is on the club web site. Camping is permitted: the gate will be open by mid-afternoon on Thursday September 12.

ELIGIBILITY: NRA membership is no longer required for people to compete in NRA tournaments. F Class competitors are encouraged to attend the match.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules Long Range and F Class Long Range Classification rules will apply. Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and MUST be used by all competitors. Bring a Temporary Score Book or results bulletin for proof of scores.

SAFETY: Bolts cannot be closed until the rifle is shouldered and pointed toward the target.

EQUIPMENT:

Palma®Rifle-Rule 3.3.1 Any Rifle Any Sight-Rule 3.7(c) F Class-Rule 3.4.1 in NRA High Power Rifle Rule Section 22

ENTRIES: Individual entries will be made by using the enclosed entry form accompanied by a check or money order. Be sure to indicate your current NRA Long Range Prone or F Class Long Range Prone classification. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6-Assignet Classification. or 19.2-Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry. Mail individual entry form with correct fees to:

Individual match entries will be accepted up to capacity of the range (128) until September 10. Entries received after September 10 will be considered late entries and will be charged a late entry fee.

FEES: make checks or money orders payable to Winnequah Gun Club or WGC:

One day Individual Matches (Friday or Saturday or Sunday) \$35.00 Two day Individual package \$60.00 Three Day Individual Package (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) \$80.00

Late entry fee: \$6.00/person (after Sept. 10)

Challenge fee: \$2.00/person

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding cards for individual matches will be issued from the Stat Office. Competitors must report to the Stat Office before firing that day. NRA Long Range Prone or F Class Long Range Prone classification card must be shown before squadding is issued. A competitor who fails to present himself/herself at the proper firing point when his/her relay is called may lose their right to compete in the event.

COURSE OF FIRE: Friday three 1000 yd Individual matches: 20 shots for record, unlimited sighters 1st match, 2 convertible sighters the next two matches in a time limit of 30 minutes each match:

Saturday three 1000 yd matches PAIR FIRE with a 2 minute blowoff period for first match then 2 convertible sighters for the next two matches, time limit 45 sec after score is called out to shooter;

Sunday two 1000 yd Individual matches, 20 shots for record, unlimited sighters for the 1st match, 2 convertible sighters for the 2nd match in a time limit of 30 minutes each match. Silver Mountain Electronic Target System will be used for scoring. Competitors will be required to score/verify. Please bring a spotting scope or binoculars for verifying all shots fired on the target. Failure to do score/verifying duties may result in a DQ.

BLOW-OFF PERIOD RULES: ALL BLOW-OFF SHOTS MUST BE FIRED AT THE 50 YARD LINE WHERE THE STEEL TARGETS ARE LOCATED. IF ANY SHOTS ARE RECORDED ON THE TARGET SYSTEM DURING THIS TIME THE SHOOTER WILL RECEIVE A MISS FOR THEIR FIRST RECORD SHOT. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!!!!

MATCHES WILL BE FIRED IN ORDER AS LISTED BELOW:

Friday Matches 1, 2 and 3: Individual – 1000yd, Palma Rifle, Any Rifle/Any Sight, F Class Open or FTR Saturday Matches 3, 4 & 5: **PAIR FIRE** – 1,000 yd, Palma Rifle, Any Rifle/Any Sight, F Class Open or FTR Sunday Matches 6, 7: Individual – 1000 yd, Palma Rifle, Any Rifle/Any Sight, F Class Open or FTR Match 8: Friday, Saturday and Sunday Aggregate

<u>AWARDS:</u> Awards will be given in cash to the individual Match Winners in each match. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given only if there are 3-6-10 or more competitors in a given match and class. If there are fewer than 3 High Masters entered, they must be for Open awards only. High Master Class may not be combined with the Master Class. If there are fewer than 5 entries in a class for awards, they will be combined with the same class in another category. A special award will be given to the Palma High competitor using a Palma Rifle in the Match Aggregate if there are more than 5 competitors.

<u>F CLASS COMPETITORS:</u> All individual events are open to participation by F Class competitors. Awards in F Class will be made based upon the number of F Class competitors in the match. A cash prize will be awarded to the highest F Class competitor, provided there are 5 or more F Class competitors entered in F Open and FTR.
